PRICING & PAYMENT

Private tuition

For private tuition, see page 5 for pricing.

Students are expected to attend **weekly** sessions with their private tutor during term time. If you cannot attend a session, you must arrange an alternative time with your tutor.

There are two ways to pay: PAYG or Prepaid

NO LOCK IN CONTRACTS FOR PAYG.

SWITCH BETWEEN PAYG AND PREPAY ANY TIME.

Pay As You Go (PAYG)

Pay for lessons after you attend them. Lessons are automatically charged to your credit/debit card every second Monday.

Prepay

Pay for lesson **before** you attend them. Pay up front and a credit of 10 hours is applied to your account.

Packages are **renewed automatically** when your balance drops below 2 hours. Every time we issue a new package, we'll send you an invoice via email to let you know. You'll have a 3 day window before the payment gets processed automatically.

Note: You must pay the Prepaid 10-Hour Package in FULL before the 10 hour credit will be applied to your account.

Private tuition

All lesson records, invoices and payment receipts are stored in your **Tutorbird** account.

MAKING PAYMENT

We accept payment via debit/credit card.

When you sign up for tutoring with us, you will be asked to provide your card details which are stored on our secure payment platform on **Tutorbird**. Details are deleted from our system once tutoring has ceased.

Our billing system is 100% automated and relies on payment via debit-credit card.

Sorry, but we do not offer other payment options.

For PAYG, we have a fortnightly billing cycle

If we use imaginary dates:

- The billing cycle runs from Monday 1st Sunday 14th
- Monday 15th is the billing day
- On Monday 15th, you are billed for all lessons that took place between the 1st 14th.

PRIVATE TUITION RESCHEDULING & CANCELLATIONS

To reschedule or cancel a private session, contact your tutor directly at least 24 hours **PRIOR** to the session.

If you reschedule or cancel a session with less than 24 hours notice, you may be charged the full cost of a tutoring session.

Weekly Sessions

You are expected to have weekly sessions. This is to ensure that you are making consistent progress. English is a challenging subject that requires regular work.

Examples of unacceptable reasons for cancelling weekly lessons:

- "I don't feel like it."
- "I just don't need help with English right now."

Examples of acceptable reasons:

- Illness
- Transport issues
- Holidays

If you cannot attend weekly sessions, the tutor's time will be wasted and other students on our waiting list would like to use that time!

TERMINATION OF PRIVATE TUITION

Step 1) Contact your tutor directly to cancel any upcoming lessons (you must give them at least 24 hours notice or charges will apply).

Step 2) Next, notify Brocklehurst Academy by emailing us at english@brocklehurstacademy.com

PAYG Students

You must notify Brocklehurst Academy within 21 days of the last lesson you attended. If you haven't attended a lesson yet, you must notify Brocklehurst Academy within 21 days of completing the sign up form. Failure to notify us within 21 days will result in a termination fee (equivalent to 1 PAYG hour).

Any unpaid lessons will be billed as per usual at the end of the current fortnightly billing cycle.

Prepaid 10-hour Package Students

Any unused balance will be refunded, minus the full price of 1 PAYG hour. Any hours previously used on the current package will be charged at PAYG price. For example:

Aleisha has purchased a Prepaid 10-Hour Package for \$1,000. She has only used 6 hours and wishes to terminate tutoring and obtain a refund. Her refund will be calculated as follows:

- 6 hours used @ \$100/hr (PAYG price) = \$600
- Termination fee (for administrative costs) = \$100
- \$600 + \$100 = \$700
- \$1,000 (original amount paid) \$700 = \$300 refund

You will be refunded at the end of our current fortnightly billing cycle. Once processed, refunds can take 5-10 business days to reach your account.

If there is not enough credit remaining to pay the PAYG lessons + termination penalty, no refund will be given

Please note a termination fee will also apply if we are forced to remove you as a student due to you not attending weekly lessons. The 21 day timeframe will be applied in this case. Please see FAQ number 7 (on page 16) for further details.

ONLINE CLASS POLICIES

Times

- Termly classes run according to the New South Wales (Australia) school terms.
- Class times are fixed and agreed upon before the commencement of each term.
- Each term consists of ten lessons.
- Each lesson is 2 hours long.
- Students will be given a 5-minute break midway through the lesson.

Teacher

• The class teacher will be arranged before the commencement of the term to teach all ten lessons. However, Brocklehurst Academy may use a different teacher in rare circumstances (for example, if the original teacher is ill).

Lesson Format

- Lessons will be conducted via Zoom and Google docs.
- Each student will receive their individual Google doc with all learning materials prior to the start of each lesson.
- Students are required to have their camera working throughout the lesson. This is to ensure they are participating in the lesson.
- Students must use the 'hand up' function for permission to speak in the lesson. Interruptions are not permitted.
- Lessons will be automatically recorded so that they can be sent to any absent students (see below).
- Video recordings of lessons will be deleted after thirty days.

ONLINE CLASS POLICIES

Homework

- Homework is set at the end of each lesson. Homework tasks will ordinarily require 30 minutes to 1 hour to complete.
- Homework must be completed in the student's Google doc, which the teacher has access to. Homework should not be emailed to the teacher.
- Homework must be completed 48 hours prior to the next lesson to allow time for the teacher to properly mark it and provide detailed feedback.
- Students should pay careful attention to the feedback and act upon any advice given.

Equipment

Students will need the following:

- A laptop or tablet that can use the software detailed below.
- A working Zoom account.
- A Gmail address so that they can use Google docs during the lessons and for homework tasks.
- If in China, a working VPN so that they can use Google docs.

Absences

- You cannot reschedule or cancel a lesson. If absent, the student will be sent a video recording (mp4) and be expected to complete the classwork and homework for that lesson (see further details on page 14).
- The teacher will provide feedback for homework as normal.

MAKING Online PAYMENT Classes

As with private tuition, we only accept payment via debit/credit card (see page 7).

For online classes, each lesson is \$100 (\$50 per hour).

Bulk payment for 10 lessons (\$1,000) is due before the first lesson of the term.

If a student misses a lesson, the missed lesson cannot be used as a credit for future lessons. Students will be emailed a video recording of the lesson (see page 13).

No refunds will be given for missed lessons or after the commencement of the term.

Trial Option for New Students

New students can opt for introductory trial lessons. This option allows you to pay for only 2 lessons (\$200), after which you do not have to continue with the class. Payments must be received before the first lesson.

FAQS

1. Are there contracts?

We don't require any contracts, giving you complete flexibility. If you're not entirely satisfied, you can discontinue tutoring at any time. Should you wish to switch tutors for any reason, we're happy to arrange that for you. Simply reach out to us directly at

3. Why do you only accept weekly students for private tuition?

Weekly tutoring ensures you get the greatest benefit from our tutors. We believe that casual, irregular sessions don't allow us to provide the level of support or achieve the results our students deserve. We're committed to your success and value working with equally dedicated students!

5. Can I pay by cash or bank transfer?

Unfortunately, no. Our billing system is fully automated and works exclusively through direct debit via credit or debit card. This streamlined process ensures smooth operations and timely payments for our dedicated tutors. At this time, we are unable to offer alternative payment methods.

2. Can I switch from PAYG to Prepaid for private tuition?

Absolutely! You can make this change at any time. Just contact us at english@brocklehurstacademy.com, and we'll update your billing preferences. You're also welcome to switch from Prepaid to PAYG if needed.

4. How do I access resources?

For private tuition and online classes, tour tutor will provide you with your own Google Drive folder and place all resources in there. You will need a working Gmail account to effectively use these resources (e.g. Google Docs etc).

6. What is the minimum number of lessons I need to attend for private tuition?

While there's no set minimum, we only accept students seeking a long-term commitment, ideally lasting until their end-of-year exams. This approach ensures we can provide the consistent support necessary to achieve the best possible results, as short-term tutoring doesn't allow us to deliver the level of impact we strive for.



7. What happens if I don't attend weekly lessons?

When you sign up with us, you agree to our Terms & Conditions, which include committing to weekly lessons during the school term.

If you are unable to attend weekly, you must notify us in advance at english@brocklehurstacademy.com.

Failure to attend weekly lessons without prior notice or arrangement may result in losing your spot at Brocklehurst Academy and incurring a termination fee. A termination fee applies under the following circumstances:


If you haven't attended a lesson yet:
